



Terms and conditions for awarding funding for the implementation of courses to improve the skills of Doctoral Candidates in the Interdisciplinary Doctoral School as part of the implementation of the project:

Curriculum for advanced Doctoral education & training - CADET Academy of TUL

(Task 9, Skills up! – courses increasing competences of Doctoral Candidates at IDS)

1. In the call for proposals for the funding of the course for improving the competences of Doctoral Candidates (hereinafter: call for proposals) is open to all Doctoral Candidates of IDS TUL.
2. The schedule and method of recruitment will be specified in the Announcement of the Head of IDS TUL (hereinafter: Announcement) in accordance with the principle of openness, transparency, respecting equal rights and equal opportunities and published on the website of the IDS TUL in the STER NAWA Projects tab.
3. The call for proposals will be carried out continuously from the date indicated in the Call for Proposals Announcement until 30.08.2023 or until all the funds allocated for the funding of the courses are used up, with the proviso that recruitment may be temporarily suspended.
4. Funding will be awarded in the order of incoming applications for 101 Doctoral Candidates. Each Candidate can only receive funding for one course.
5. The condition of receiving funding for a course is to submit a fully completed application form with the required signatures according to the specimen.
6. The following courses will be accepted:
 - a) chosen by the Doctoral Candidates of IDS TUL, in agreement with the supervisor, from the offer of renowned research centres all over the world (included in the top 50 universities according to the list of the <https://www.timeshighereducation.com/world-university-rankings/2022>)
 - b) implemented via online platforms
 - c) starting no earlier than 7 days from the date of application to the IDS Office, ending no later than 17.09.2023.
 - d) accepted in the form of a signature by a representative of the discipline in which the Doctoral Candidate is studying (the Doctoral Candidate's supervisor or a person designated from the discipline, signature in part IV of the Application).
7. Doctoral Candidates will be informed about the awarded funding individually, by contacting an employee of the Project Service Centre of TUL.
8. The Doctoral Candidate undertakes to deliver to the office of the IDS TUL, within 14 days from the end of the course, a copy of the certificate or confirmation of participation in the course in the form of information from the course organiser (if the organiser has not provided certificates for participants).
9. If the funding for the courses is exhausted, a notice of the end of the call for proposals will be published on the IDS TUL website under Projects - STER, and the call for proposals will be discontinued.
