XVIII Rzeszów Conference of Young Physicists

§ 1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. **The XVIII Rzeszów Conference of Young Physicists**, later referred to as the "*Conference*," will take place on **May 29–30, 2025**, in person at the Faculty of Science and Technology of the University of Rzeszów, Building A0, located at Pigoń Street 1, 35-959 Rzeszów, Poland.
2. *The Conference* is organized by **the Association of Physicists of the University of Rzeszów**, with support from the Faculty of Science and Technology of the University of Rzeszów. The leading patronage of *the Conference* is provided by the Doctoral School of the University of Rzeszów, the Polish Physical Society (Rzeszów Branch), Visum Clinic, and the Subcarpathian Renewable Energy Cluster.
3. Any natural person holding the status of a student, PhD student, or employee of a higher education institution is eligible to participate in the conference.
4. Submitting an application to *the Organizer* constitutes acceptance of this Status by *the Participant*.

§ 2. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. There are two forms of participation in *the Conference*:
 - a. **passive** – in this form, *Participants* may attend presentations as listeners and engage in discussions. Passive Participants are not entitled to a certificate of participation. To sign up for this type of participation, please send an email to the Organizer at knf@ur.edu.pl.
 - b. **active** – in this form, *Participants* may present their submitted work through a talk or a scientific poster in Polish or English. Active Participants will receive a certificate of participation.
2. To gain **active Participant** status, the following requirements must be fulfilled:
 - a. registration via the online form by **February 28, 2025**, including submitting an abstract and additional required details in the registration form;

- b. fulfillment of substantive and formal requirements by the submitted abstract subject to review by the Conference Scientific Committee - qualification information will be sent by e-mail to the mailing address indicated in the form;
 - c. **payment of the conference fee** and submission of a bank transaction confirmation to *the Organizer's* email within 20 business days of receiving the qualification notification;
 - d. the conference fee includes conference materials, coffee breaks, and lunches.
3. Active participation in the Conference includes:
- a. speech – a multimedia presentation with a maximum duration of 15 minutes, including time for discussion.
 - b. **poster presentation** – prepare results in the form of a scientific poster (size A0 or A1). The participant must be present at their poster during the designated poster session.
4. All active participants will receive a certificate confirming their participation at the end of the Conference.
5. Participants must register on time, including abstract submission via the form.

If special characters not present in the Polish alphabet are used in the title or abstract, the text must be formatted in **LaTeX** and sent as a **.tex** or **.pdf** file to ***knf@ur.edu.pl***.

6. Participants will be informed of the qualification or rejection of their abstracts within 10 business days of the registration deadline.
7. Upon receiving the qualification notification, *Participants* must pay **the** conference fee of **250 PLN (before tax)** to the bank account provided in the email (within the timeframe indicated in §2, item 2, letter c of the Statute) and send the transaction confirmation to ***knf@ur.edu.pl***.
- Failure to make the payment excludes the participant from the Conference.**
8. Upon payment of the conference fee, the *Participant* is officially qualified to attend the *Conference*.
9. The conference fee is non-refundable in case of withdrawal from participation.
10. Awards and distinctions will be granted during the closing of the *Conference*, based on the decision of the Conference Scientific Committee.

11. *Participants* who are also members of the Organizing Committee are not eligible to receive awards or distinctions for speech or poster presentations.

§ 3. CONFERENCE REGISTRATION

1. The registration deadline for the *Conference* is **February 28, 2025, at 11:59 PM**. After this date, registration will be closed. The Organizer reserves the right to extend the registration period.
2. *The Organizer* will establish the *Conference* schedule and reserves the right to make changes, including on the event day. Changes may include modifications to the schedule, the order of presentations, or reducing the *Conference* to a single day.
3. *The Organizer* reserves the right to select submitted topics and qualify them for speech or poster sessions. If the submitted abstract does not meet substantive or formal requirements, it may be rejected. Decisions regarding qualifications are made by the Conference Scientific Committee.

§ 4. FINAL CONDITIONS

1. Formal and substantive requirements for abstracts are outlined in *Appendix No. 1* to this Status.
2. The information clause for conference participants is provided in *Appendix No. 2* to this Status.

Substantive and Formal Requirements for Abstracts.

Abstract Content

1. The abstract must include the results of the *Participant's* original research/experiments/analyses. It must not be only a compilation of published results by other authors.
2. The *Conference* focuses on topics related to physics or their applications in other fields.

Formatting Requirements

1. The abstract must not exceed 1 page of A4 size.
2. It should be written in the language of the presentation (Polish or English).
3. Citations should follow the format:
[Authors, title, name of book/material/journal, page number, year of publication].
4. Abstracts may include tables, images, and drawings in .jpg or .png formats. In such cases, a .docx file with these elements must also be submitted to the Organizer's email.

GDPR Information Clause for Conference Participants

- By Article 13 of the GDPR, we inform you that your personal data provided to us via the contact form or through other means (e.g., sharing a business card, sending an email, or contacting us by phone) is collected, processed, and stored to facilitate communication and for the purposes for which it was made available to us.
